The Richard B. and Constance L. Lewis Spanish Education Fund Committee invites **full-time students pursuing a graduate degree in Spanish or an undergraduate degree with a declared major or minor in Spanish** to submit applications for awards of up to \$1000 (to be disbursed in Academic Year 2007-2008). **The awards are intended to assist with educational expenses including, but not limited to: tuition, books, and study abroad.** Applicants must be U.S. citizens, must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA, and must demonstrate financial need. Students should specifically address financial need in their application. **(NOTE: preference will be given to students who have not previously received the Lewis Educational Scholarship Award.)**

Application Materials:

Applicants must submit one original and four copies of a completed application, including:

- 1) This application form, completed and signed.
- 2) An unofficial transcript (including spring-semester grades)
- 3) A 250-500 word essay explaining financial need and intended use of funds awarded.

Additionally, applicants must request a letter of recommendation from one Spanish teacher at U of L (to be submitted directly to the Committee). [***Please be courteous and give your recommender **adequate time** to complete your recommendation letter].

Deadline: Monday, February 25, 2008. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
